Who For?

The Large Group is open to all who are interested in exploring and articulating the harder-to-hear background sounds, voices, movements and emerging themes of their lives and to find ways of applying what they learn to their everyday lives, relationships, communities and society.

The Large Group will be conducted by Teresa von Sommaruga Howard.

*Teresa has many cultural influences in her personal and professional background. Born in England of a German refugee father and British mother, she immigrated to New Zealand as a child. She is a registered architect, systemic family therapist and has developed expertise conducting median and large groups. Teresa has applied these three disciplines: architecture, systemic practice, and group analysis in larger settings in various contexts around the world. Increasingly Teresa has focussed on the way unrecognised trauma resulting from socio-political upheaval transmitted through generations, reveals itself in the large group. She has written extensively about her work with large groups and co-authored *Design through Dialogue: A Guide for Clients and Architects* (Wiley, 2010). She is an honorary member of the Institute of Group Analysis (London)*
