

A CONVERSAZIONE WITH STEPHEN ARCARI

**MORE THINGS YOU ALWAYS WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT GROUPS
BUT WERE AFRAID TO ASK**

Following on from Stephen Arcari's engaging conversazione in July 2014, he returns to engage in another informed conversation addressing the following:

- A Brief History of Groups.
- What happens in groups without a 'task'?
- Structure v non-structure - what does it mean to say a group is non-structured?

The presentation will be followed by a discussion, led by Stephen, where participants can draw on their own experiences in groups. This will include reflections from members of a currently ongoing group about their own experiences and the questions which arise.

Stephen Arcari qualified as a Group Analyst in 1986. Since then he has been involved with the training work of the Institute of Group Analysis (London) firstly at a foundation level and then from 2002 as a Training Analyst and Supervisor. Currently he is the chair of The London Courses Committee one of the three centres across the United Kingdom offering a full training in Group Analysis. Over 40 years he has held several senior NHS postings and conducted a private practice working with individuals, groups and non-statutory agencies.
